Summary: Sales tax, property tax exemptions; leased motor vehicles of serviceman or political subdivision under certain terms

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 12-36-2120, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS FROM THE STATE SALES TAX, SO AS TO EXEMPT THE SALES TAX ON A MOTOR VEHICLE LEASED BY A SERVICEMAN WHO IS THE RESIDENT OF ANOTHER STATE BUT WHO IS IN THIS STATE BY REASON OF ORDERS, UPON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE EXEMPTION APPLIES TO A MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASED BY THAT SERVICEMAN; AND TO EXEMPT THE SALES TAX ON A MOTOR VEHICLE LEASED BY A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION FOR USE EXCLUSIVELY FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES; AND TO AMEND SECTION 12-37-220, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS FROM AD VALOREM TAXATION, SO AS TO EXEMPT A MOTOR VEHICLE WHICH IS LEASED BY A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION FOR USE EXCLUSIVELY FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES.
