H 3889 General Bill, By Pinson and Rice

Summary: Building Codes Enforcement Officer

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 6-8-10, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF A BUILDING CODES ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, SO AS TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL DEFINITIONS OF RELATED TERMS; TO AMEND SECTION 6-8-20, RELATING TO RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA BUILDING CODES COUNCIL, SO AS TO REQUIRE THE COUNCIL TO PUBLISH A LIST OF REGISTRANTS AND TO DELETE OTHER REPORTING REQUIREMENTS; TO AMEND SECTION 6-8-30, RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF CERTIFICATES OF REGISTRATION, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT AN UNCERTIFIED PERSON EMPLOYED AS A BUILDING CODES ENFORCEMENT OFFICER MUST BE GRANTED PROVISIONAL REGISTRATION WITHOUT EXAMINATION AND SUBJECT TO ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS; TO AMEND SECTION 6-8-40, RELATING TO THE REQUIREMENT OF REGISTRATION TO PRACTICE AS A BUILDING CODES ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AND PENALTIES FOR A VIOLATION, SO AS TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND EXCEPTIONS FOR AN ARCHITECT OR ENGINEER; TO AMEND SECTION 6-8-50, RELATING TO THE AVAILABILITY OF INJUNCTIVE RELIEF AGAINST A VIOLATOR, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT RELIEF MAY BE SOUGHT FROM THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW COURT, AMONG OTHER THINGS; TO AMEND SECTION 6-8-60, RELATING TO APPLICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION, SO AS TO MAKE CONFORMING CHANGES AND TO PROVIDE THAT REGISTRATION AUTHORIZES A REGISTRANT TO PRACTICE IN A SPECIFIC CONSTRUCTION TRADE DISCIPLINE; AND TO AMEND SECTION 6-8-70, RELATING TO THE DURATION OF A CERTIFICATE AND CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS, SO AS TO MAKE CONFORMING CHANGES.
