Summary: Uninsured motorist premium, Insurance Department to collect tax and audit annually; Motor Vehicles, Accidents

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 38-73-470, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO DISPOSITION OF THE UNINSURED MOTORIST PREMIUM, SO AS TO CHANGE CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, INCLUDING ADDING A REQUIREMENT THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE ADMINISTER THE COLLECTION OF THE TAX ON UNINSURED MOTORIST COVERAGE PREMIUMS AND AUDIT THE TAX ON AN ANNUAL BASIS; AND TO AMEND SECTION 56-5-1270, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATORS AND OWNERS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS MAKE WRITTEN REPORTS OF CERTAIN ACCIDENTS AND INVESTIGATIONS, SO AS TO LOWER THE THRESHOLD AMOUNT OF TOTAL PROPERTY DAMAGE FROM ONE THOUSAND TO FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS.
