A Joint Resolution to establish the Joint Legislative Committee on Children and Families, to provide for its membership of three members of the House of Representatives, three members of the Senate, and three gubernatorial appointees, and to further provide that the committee shall study such issues relating to children and families as directed or requested by the General Assembly.
