A JOINT RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE SOUTH CAROLINA HIGHER EDUCATION REALIGNMENT COMMISSION TO EXAMINE EACH PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER LEARNING IN THIS STATE AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS AS TO WHICH INSTITUTIONS OR PROGRAMS SHOULD BE PERMANENTLY REALIGNED OR MERGED WITH OR TRANSFERRED TO OTHER INSTITUTIONS OR PROGRAMS, TO PROVIDE FOR THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION, TO PROVIDE THE PROCEDURES FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF THE COMMISSION'S REPORT INCLUDING A PROVISION THAT IT IS DEEMED ADOPTED UNLESS DISAPPROVED BY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THAT BEYOND SUCH DISAPPROVAL THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY MAKE NO FURTHER CHANGES IN OR AMENDMENTS TO THE REPORT, TO PROVIDE TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS FOR THOSE INSTITUTIONS OR PROGRAMS WHICH ARE CLOSED, MERGED, OR TRANSFERRED, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE COMMISSION IS TERMINATED ON JULY 1, 2004.
