H*4091 (Rat #0285, Act #0280 of 1989) General Bill, By J.E. Lockemy and B.H. Harwell

A Bill to provide for an advisory referendum in Dillon County as to whether or not the qualified electors of the county favor having a seven-member county board of education to be elected in nonpartisan elections from the same seven single-member election districts from which members of the Dillon County Council are elected, and to amend an Act of 1989 bearing Ratification Number 182, relating to authorized millage for school purposes in Dillon County for fiscal year 1989-90, so as to revise this millage.-amended title
