S 0427 General Bill, By Ford

Summary: Towing of vehicle or other object by law enforcement officer; provision for law enforcement agency to sell

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-5-2522, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE PROCEDURE FOR THE DISPOSAL OF A VEHICLE OR OBJECT THAT IS DIRECTED TO BE TOWED BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR THE ACCRUAL OF ADDITIONAL STORAGE CHARGES AFTER NOTICE IS MAILED TO THE OWNER OR LIEN HOLDER, TO PROVIDE THAT A VEHICLE TOWED AT THE DIRECTION OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AND STORED IN THE POSSESSION OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY MAY BE SOLD BY THE AGENCY THAT HAD IT TOWED, AND TO PROVIDE THAT A VEHICLE TOWED AT THE DIRECTION OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AND STORED BY THE TOWING COMPANY MAY BE SOLD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 29-25-10.
