H 4322 General Bill, By M.A. Pitts, Loftis and Toole

Summary: Failure to stop for law enforcement officer

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-5-750, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE OFFENSE OF FAILURE TO STOP A MOTOR VEHICLE WHEN SIGNALLED TO STOP BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE, SO AS TO REVISE THE CONDUCT THAT CONSTITUTES THE OFFENSE, TO REVISE THE PENALTIES FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS PROVISION, TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS PROVISION MAY HAVE HIS CRIMINAL RECORD EXPUNGED UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL RESTRICTED DRIVER'S LICENSE; AND TO AMEND SECTION 56-5-2947, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE OFFENSE OF CHILD ENDANGERMENT, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WHO IS FOUND GUILTY OF FAILURE TO STOP A MOTOR VEHICLE WHEN SIGNALLED TO STOP BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE IS NOT GUILTY ALSO OF THE OFFENSE OF CHILD ENDANGERMENT.
