A Bill to amend Section 56-5-1520, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to speed limits, so as to provide that the maximum speed limit on an interstate highway is seventy miles an hour; and to repeal Section 56-5-1510, relating to the State's fifty-five mile an hour maximum speed limit and federal laws that permit the state to set speed limits greater than fifty-five miles an hour.
