H 4325 General Bill, By Kirsh and Toole

Summary: Bond bill must be used on state-owned projects or for state purposes

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 2-7-77 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT ANY STATE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN AN ANNUAL OR SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OR IN A BOND BILL MUST BE EXPENDED ON STATE-OWNED PROJECTS OR FOR STATE PURPOSES AND TO PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS.
