A Bill to amend Section 20-7-410, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to jurisdiction of certain violations by juveniles, so as to require the family courts to report also violations that affect the juvenile's privilege to drive; to amend Section 56-1-745, as amended, relating to suspension of driver's licenses for controlled substance violations, so as to make technical corrections and to define controlled substance violations; to amend Section 56-1-747, relating to what constitutes a conviction for suspension purposes, so as to include juvenile proceedings.
