Summary: Coin-operated devices, video games with free play feature; Gambling, Taxation, Political Subdivisions, Counties A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 12-21-2805 SO AS TO AUTHORIZE A MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY BY ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE LOCATION OF VIDEO GAMES WITH A FREE PLAY FEATURE WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY BY MEANS OF ZONING OR OTHER ORDINANCES GENERALLY APPLICABLE TO CLASSES OF BUSINESS ACTIVITY, PROVIDE THAT THE OWNER OF THE MACHINE ON WHICH THESE GAMES ARE PLAYED MUST HAVE OBTAINED A LOCAL LOCATION LICENSE BEFORE IT IS LICENSED OR RELICENSED, AND TO PROVIDE A PROCEDURE FOR CONFISCATION AND SALE OF THESE MACHINES DETERMINED TO BE IN VIOLATION OF LOCAL ORDINANCE.
