### **S\*0494 (Rat #0025, Act #0185 of 1995) General Bill, By Courtney**

A Bill to provide a minimum distance within which a commercial construction, demolition, and land-clearing landfill in Spartanburg County may not be located from an existing aquaculture farm or facility and to provide exceptions and definitions.
