Summary: Trans fat

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 44-1-143 SO AS TO DEFINE A RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENT, TO REQUIRE A RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENT THAT SELLS FOOD CONTAINING TRANS FAT OR COOKED IN TRANS FAT MUST PROVIDE CERTAIN CONSPICUOUS WARNINGS THAT THE FOOD CONTAINS TRANS FAT OR WAS COOKED IN TRANS FAT, TO PROVIDE THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THESE WARNINGS; AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION.
