Summary: Post-Conviction DNA Procedures Act

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING ARTICLE 3 TO CHAPTER 27, TITLE 17 SO AS TO ENACT THE "POST-CONVICTION DNA PROCEDURES ACT", TO PROVIDE PROCEDURES FOR DNA TESTING FOR PERSONS CONVICTED OF CRIMINAL OFFENSES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING THE IDENTITY OF THE PERPETRATOR, AND TO ALLOW POST-CONVICTION PROCEEDINGS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.
