A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 61-4-510, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO SPECIAL RETAIL BEER AND WINE PERMITS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT AN APPLICANT WHO, FOR RELIGIOUS PURPOSES, REGULARLY CLOSES HIS BUSINESS DURING A PERIOD OTHER THAN THE PERIOD SPECIFIED IN SECTIONS 61-4-120, 61-4-130, AND 61-4-140 SHALL PAY AN ANNUAL FEE FOR THIS SPECIAL RETAIL PERMIT OF TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS, RATHER THAN ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS, AND TO AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE OF THESE PERMITS FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION TO AN APPLICANT WHO, FOR RELIGIOUS PURPOSES, REGULARLY CLOSES HIS BUSINESS DURING A PERIOD OTHER THAN THE PERIOD SPECIFIED IN SECTIONS 61-4-120, 61-4-130, AND 61-4-140, AND TO ESTABLISH AN ANNUAL FEE FOR THESE PERMITS OF TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS; AND TO AMEND SECTION 61-6-2010 OF THE 1976 CODE, RELATING TO TEMPORARY PERMITS TO SELL ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS IN SEALED CONTAINERS OF TWO OUNCES OR LESS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT AN APPLICANT DOES NOT HAVE TO PAY THE APPLICATION FEE OR THE DAILY PERMIT FEE IF THE APPLICANT CLOSES HIS BUSINESS FOR RELIGIOUS PURPOSES DURING A PERIOD OTHER THAN THE PERIOD AUTHORIZED BY THE PERMIT ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION.
