Summary: Property tax exemptions, requirement must receive interest in dwelling of deceased spouse delete; Veterans'

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 12-37-220, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS, SO AS TO DELETE THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A VETERAN ONE HUNDRED PERCENT PERMANENTLY AND TOTALLY DISABLED FOR A SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY OR THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A PARAPLEGIC OR HEMIPLEGIC MUST RECEIVE BY DEVISE THE INTEREST IN THE DWELLING OF THE DECEASED SPOUSE IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN THE EXEMPTION AND TO MAKE THIS CHANGE EFFECTIVE FOR PROPERTY TAX YEARS BEGINNING AFTER 1997.
