A BILL TO AMEND TITLE 40, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS, BY ADDING CHAPTER 76, SO AS TO ENACT THE "PROFESSIONAL ADDICTIONS COUNSELOR LICENSING ACT", TO PROVIDE FOR LICENSURE AND REGULATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, LICENSING AND REGULATION, AND TO ESTABLISH LICENSE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS FOR "PROFESSIONAL ADDICTIONS COUNSELORS AND PROFESSIONAL ADDICTIONS COUNSELOR SUPERVISORS"; TO DEFINE ACTS OF MISCONDUCT AND TO PROVIDE DISCIPLINARY ACTION AND PROCEDURES FOR MISCONDUCT, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES.
