### **S\*0735 (Rat #0410, Act #0360 of 1984) General Bill, By Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources**

A Bill to amend the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Sections 1-1-680, 1-1-690, and 1-1-695, so as to promote the agricultural industry of South Carolina by designating the peach as the official fruit of the State, milk as the official state beverage, and the lettered olive as the official state seashell.-amended title
