S*0747 Concurrent Resolution, By McConnell and Passailaigue

A Concurrent Resolution designating June 28, 1995, as "Carolina Day" in commemoration of the events of June 28, 1776, when a group of out-manned and out-gunned South Carolinians, under the leadership of Colonel William Moultrie, turned back the attack of a powerful British fleet bent on capturing Charleston in the early days of the American Revolution.

04/18/95 Senate Introduced, adopted, sent to House SJ-16

04/19/95 House Introduced, adopted, returned with concurrence HJ-14
