A BILL TO AMEND CHAPTER 2, TITLE 37, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO CONSUMER CREDIT SALES, AND CHAPTER 3, TITLE 37, RELATING TO CONSUMER LOANS, BY ADDING SECTIONS 37-2-307 AND 37-3-307, RESPECTIVELY, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A CONSUMER CREDIT SELLER SHALL MAKE CERTAIN DISCLOSURES REGARDING CREDIT INQUIRIES TO AN APPLICANT OR PROSPECTIVE APPLICANT BEFORE THE SELLER MAKES AN INQUIRY WITH A CONSUMER REPORTING AGENCY CONCERNING THE CREDITWORTHINESS OR CREDIT STANDING OF THE APPLICANT OR PROSPECTIVE APPLICANT.
