### **S\*0754 (Rat #0409, Act #0359 of 1984) General Bill, By Senate Finance**

#### ***Similar (S 0652)***

A Bill to amend Section 23-23-70, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to fine and bond forfeiture financing for the South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy, so as to provide for amounts to be added to fines and bonds to be used for the financing of the academy and the Law Enforcement Hall of Fame and to provide that the additional funds must be assessed and collected by the courts of this State or law enforcement officers authorized to accept bond.-amended title
