### **S 0806 General Bill, By Mescher**

A BILL TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO ESTABLISH A SCHEDULE OF FLEXIBLE CONTRIBUTION RATES AND/OR OTHER MECHANISMS OR PLANS TO OFFER TO ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES WITH A MINIMUM OF TWENTY-FIVE YEARS OF CREDITED SERVICE IN THE SYSTEM SO AS TO ENABLE AN ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEE TO RETIRE WITH LESS THAN THIRTY YEARS OF CREDITED SERVICE WITHOUT CAUSING A NEGATIVE ACTUARIAL IMPACT ON THE STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND AT THE SAME TIME ALLOWING AN ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEE TO RETIRE WITH LESS THAN THIRTY YEARS OF CREDITED SERVICES WITHOUT A PENALTY TO THE EMPLOYEE OR A DIMINUTION OF THE RETIREMENT BENEFIT OF THE EMPLOYEE.
