Summary: State budget process

A BILL TO AMEND ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 11, TITLE 11, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE STATE BUDGET PROCESS, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN INFORMATION PROVIDED TO THE GOVERNOR FOR THE UNDERTAKINGS OF STATE GOVERNMENT BE SENT TO THE SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE, TO PROVIDE THAT THE SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE CONSTITUTE A JOINT APPROPRIATION COMMITTEE WHICH SHALL MEET TO CONSIDER AND ESTABLISH THE PROJECTED ANNUAL REVENUE AND CERTAIN REQUIRED ALLOCATIONS ON WHICH THE ANNUAL GENERAL APPROPRIATION BILL MUST BE BASED AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE BILL WHICH RECEIVES THIRD READING FIRST IN EITHER BODY SHALL BE THE RECORD BILL FOR PURPOSES FINAL PASSAGE AND TO REPEAL SECTIONS 11-11-100 AND SECTION 11-11-140.
