S 0918 General Bill, By Hawkins

Summary: Aromatic hydrocarbons, intentionally smelling, inhaling or possessing; driver's license to be suspended

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-1-746, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE SUSPENSION OF A PERSON'S DRIVER'S LICENSE UPON A CONVICTION OF CERTAIN OFFENSES RELATING TO THE POSSESSION, SALE, AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, AND THE UNLAWFUL USE OR ALTERATION OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THIS PROVISION ALSO APPLIES TO THE INTENTIONAL SMELLING OR INHALING OF FUMES FROM OR THE USE OR POSSESSION OF ANY SUBSTANCE CONTAINING AROMATIC HYDROCARBONS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.
