Summary: Unemployment benefits

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 41-35-110 OF THE 1976 CODE, RELATING TO CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY FOR UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS, TO PROVIDE THAT A CLAIMANT FOR UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR BENEFITS OR WAITING PERIOD CREDIT FOLLOWING A TEMPORARY WORK ASSIGNMENT UNLESS HE CAN SHOW THE TEMPORARY WORK AGENCY HAS BEEN NOTIFIED OF THE AVAILABILITY OF THE CLAIMANT FOR A NEW JOB ASSIGNMENT FROM THE AGENCY BUT HAS NOT PROVIDED A SUBSEQUENT ASSIGNMENT FOR WHICH THE CLAIMANT IS QUALIFIED.
