A Bill to amend Section 40-51-65, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to licensing and examination of applicants to practice podiatry, so as to delete the provisions on the minimum required number of scholastic years and on temporary licenses and to provide for a recognized college of podiatric medicine to be accredited by the Council on Podiatric Medical Education.-amended title
