RE: SUNS Numbers Report

Proviso 1A.50 of the FY 2022-23 General Appropriations Act states that:

For the current fiscal year, the Department of Education and the Office of First Steps to School Readiness must acquire unique student identifiers or SUNS numbers for each student enrolled in the CDEPP program no later than the 45th day and must provide a report of such to the House Ways and Means Committee, the House Education Committee, the Senate Finance Committee, the Senate Education Committee and the Education Oversight Committee by November thirtieth.

It has come to our attention that while SUNS numbers were acquired for each student last year per the proviso, this report was not adequately filed with the appropriate committees. In the interest of transparency, we now submit the following.

Pursuant to the terms of the proviso, we are writing to inform you that First Steps provided the student files for 3,243 enrolled students on our Day 45, October 18, 2022, to the SC Department of Education for the assignment of unique student identifiers. We received the file back on November 20, 2022 from SCDE with those acquired SUNS numbers.
