**State Expenditure**

This bill would require the Department of Transportation to erect signs along the state's highways to inform motorists that trucks and slower moving vehicles must travel in the farthest right lane in either direction along all multi-lane portions of the highway, where appropriate.

**The Department of Transportation.** The department indicates that the cost of erecting signs along the highways for the purposes of this bill would be \$50,000 in FY 2016-17.
