Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Expenditure

This bill amends 16-23-420 to allow registered students, employees, and faculty members of public or private higher education institutions who are authorized to carry a concealed weapon to possess a firearm on any premises or property owned, operated, or controlled by the institution. These individuals may not possess firearms in locations that have a “No Concealable Weapons Allowed” sign posted.

SC Commission of Higher Education and SC Technical and Comprehensive Education Board indicate this bill will have a minimal impact on General Fund, Federal Fund, or Other Fund expenditures that can be absorbed within existing appropriations for institutions that may post “No Concealable Weapons Allowed” signs.
