## **Explanation of Fiscal Impact**

# Introduced on January 10, 2017

### **State Expenditure**

This bill creates the South Carolina Family Court Study Committee. This six member committee will review family court policies, practices, and procedures regarding temporary hearings, child support, and alimony, among other responsibilities. The committee will make a report to the General Assembly by December 31, 2018, concerning recommendations on proposed changes to the laws related to such policies, practices, and procedures, after which the committee will dissolve.

The committee will consist of three members of the Senate appointed by the Senate Judiciary Committee Chairman and three members of the House or Representatives appointed by the House of Representatives Judiciary Committee Chairman. Each member will receive per diem of \$35, subsistence of \$195.53, and mileage for each meeting on non-session days. These expenses will be managed within the budgets of the appointees' respective legislative bodies. Staffing for the committee will be provided by the Chairman of the Senate and House Judiciary Committees and will be managed with existing staff and within exiting appropriations. Therefore, the bill does not have an expenditure impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds for the Senate or the House of Representatives
