Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Amended by the Senate on March 29, 2018 State Expenditure

This bill excludes super-karts from the requirements of the South Carolina Amusement Rides Safety Code, which states that amusement devices may not be operated without a permit issued by LLR. This bill also defines and creates provisions for the operation of super-karts. LLR reports only one facility that operates karts subject to this exemption. This bill does not materially alter the responsibilities of LLR. Therefore, this bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.
