Fiscal Impact Summary

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on May 11, 2017

State Expenditure

This bill proposes to amend the state constitution to allow the General Assembly to enact term limitations and set the salaries for legislatures. The proposed amendments must be submitted to the qualified electors at the next general election. The wording to be printed on the ballots is provided by the bill. The Election Commission is responsible for ensuring the ballots are printed with the correct wording and provided to the various precincts. The commission anticipates being able to update the ballots with the provided language for a minimal cost that can be managed within existing appropriations as preparing ballots is within their normal scope of business. Therefore, this bill would have no impact on the General Fund, Other Funds, or Federal Funds.
