Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill adds an exemption to the mandatory electronic prescribing of a Schedule II controlled substance when a licensed dentist writes the prescription for not more than a six-day supply for acute pain management or postoperative pain management.

This bill requires the Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) to perform activities that can be managed within the normal course of business. Therefore, the bill will have no expenditure impact on DHEC.
