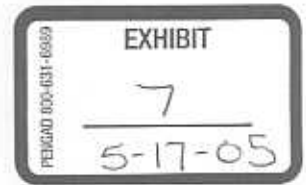



As per our telephone conversation of Friday, May 6, 2005, and pursuant to my earlier request of Santee Cooper, through its General Counsel, James Brogdon, I am requesting copies of any document forwarded to your client, in any form, by Mr. Keith Munson which references, includes, or attaches materials included as a "Foreword" in your client's evaluative report on Santee Cooper released May 5, 2005.
