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Increase of Other Funds Authorization (BD-100 Process)

SECTION 2-65-40

South Carolina Federal and Other Funds Oversight Act

Allows Agencies to increase spending authorization when approved by the Budget and Control Board (Office of State Budget).

South Carolina Code of Laws

SECTION 2-65-20

The General Assembly shall appropriate all anticipated federal and other funds for the operations of state agencies in the appropriations act and must include any conditions on the expenditure of these funds as part of the appropriations act, consistent with federal laws and regulations. Increases in project amounts as appropriated in the act must be authorized in accordance with the procedures set forth in Section 2-65-40, consistent with policies as provided in the appropriations act and other applicable laws and regulations.

Purpose

- This process is a "Bridge" from the time an agency prepares its Other Funds revenue estimates in the detail budget, passage of the annual Appropriations Act and implementation of the agency budget.
- It allows for budgeting of unanticipated Other Funds.
- Other Funds revenue estimates are made in September/October prior to passage of the Appropriations Act and beginning of the fiscal year on July 1.

Criteria for Increase Other Funds Authorization

SECTION 2-65-40. Expenditure of "other" funds; authorization; Committee reports.

- A. A state agency may spend "other" funds above the amount in the appropriations act and increases in anticipated federal programs if the expenditure of the funds receives the authorization of the board.
- B. Authorizations under this section are subject to the following standards, as applicable:
 - 1) The proposed use of the funds do not result in a fund of surplus money which may be used by the agency to expand programs without legislative approval;

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- 2) If the funds are earmarked for specific use in the appropriations act, or by federal law or regulation, any additional funds must be used for the same purpose;
- 3) If the increase results from a fee or charge for service, the agency has the legal authority to impose the fee, and has secured any approvals required by applicable law or regulations;
- 4) The proposed use of funds assists the state agency to achieve objectives or goals in keeping with the recognized powers and functions of the state agency;
- 5) If the funds are generated from a new revenue source:
 - a) The proposed use of funds covers only a minimum amount of administrative costs necessary to support the revenue collection, and any excess must be remitted to the general fund of the State;

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b) It is determined that the requesting state agency is the appropriate entity to carry out the proposed activities and no duplication of services is created by the authorization.

Office of State Budget Process

Request for Increase in Expenditure Authorization

- An agency must have both revenue receipts (cash) and authorization to spend Other Funds.
- Is cash available? (i.e. brought forward from previous year) or
- Is the request supported by increase in projected revenue? (i.e. agency grant)
- Authorization/Justification (i.e. proviso or statute)
- Does the proposed use of funds assist the state agency to achieve its mission and objectives in keeping with the recognized powers and functions of the agency?
