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USC Upstate Introduction to the Accountability Report

As USC Upstate enters the fourth year of implementation of our Strategic Plan, the leadership team continues its campus-wide assessment of resources, processes and outcomes. Even in a year responding to a global pandemic, these efforts are yielding continual improvements that are benefiting students, faculty, staff, and the Upstate communities we serve. The Honorable J. Derham Cole, Jr. led USC Upstate in 2020-2021 as Interim Chancellor. Interim Chancellor Cole remained committed to focusing on the university’s strategic priorities and responding to the changing needs of students, employees, and community. Even in these unprecedented times, USC Upstate has continued to move forward.

The 2018-2023 Strategic Plan *Up. Together* identifies three strategic priorities in creating transformative opportunities for students, employees, and the community at large:

- Priority 1: Providing Rigorous, Career Relevant, and Accessible Education
- Priority 2: Enhancing the Quality of Life in Upstate South Carolina
- Priority 3: Being the University of Choice for Faculty and Staff, Students, and the Community

These priorities guide improvements at USC Upstate, as we stay focused on associated goals and core metrics related to student success, academic excellence, community engagement, and institutional effectiveness. USC Upstate created a Strategic Planning Operational Team to help the campus to stay focused on Strategic Priorities. Two Leadership Development Institutes were held that focused on Priorities 1 and 3, each with over 100 campus leaders in attendance. A Campus Climate/Employee Engagement survey was developed and administered to all employees and each of the divisions continued to refine the goals, measures and action steps that are captured in their scorecards and unit-level continuous improvement blueprints.

New and developing 2020-2021 initiatives at USC Upstate that are helping to realize our strategic priorities, despite the distractions of a global pandemic, include the following:

Priority 1: Providing Rigorous, Career Relevant and Accessible Education

- The George Dean Johnson, Jr. College of Business and Economics began offering a B.S. in Business Administration with six majors: Economics/Finance, Accounting, Management, Marketing, Logistics and Supply Chain Management, and Entrepreneurship and Innovation in fall 2020, which was a transition from offering a B.S. in Business Administration with six concentrations;
- The M.S. in Exercise Science was approved by SC CHE in spring 2021 and sent to SACSCOC for approval;
- The B.S. in Health Information Management passed the USC Upstate Faculty Senate and is being sent to SC CHE for approval;

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- The Mary Black School of Nursing completed a successful Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) reaccreditation, having met the industry’s highest standards;
- The Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP) Steering Committee reviewed institutional data and met with multiple constituents resulting in a QEP proposal for USC Upstate’s *Professional and Career Growth Initiative: Moving Up*.

Priority 2: Enhancing the Quality of Life in Upstate South Carolina

- Dr. Araceli Hernandez-LaRoache was named Director of the new *South Carolina Centro Latino Center* bridging cultures statewide through linguistic awareness and accessibility and creating institutional space for belonging, civility, wellness and equity.
- The Mary Black School of Nursing (MBSON) was awarded a four-year, \$1.95 million grant from the federal Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) that will support MBSON’s *Holistic Opportunities and Partnerships that Empower (HOPE) Nursing Success Project* to increase the percentage of lower division nursing students from underrepresented, ethnic and minority backgrounds who progress to upper division nursing and to increase the graduation percentage of upper division nursing students from those backgrounds;
- The Mary Black School of Nursing was awarded a nearly \$76,000 grant from the federal Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) in support of its Nurse Faculty Loan Program (NFLP) which will serve as a loan fund to cover the costs of tuition, fees, books and reasonable education expenses for graduate nursing students enrolled in USC Upstate’s Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) Education program;
- USC Upstate received a nearly \$100,000 U.S. Department of Education Fulbright Hayes grant for the PI, Dr. Dave Marlow, to take K-12 teachers and USC Upstate students in the teacher education program to Costa Rica and Nicaragua for a cross-cultural comparison of language, cultural identity, and educational structures in support of diversity-enriched pedagogy (travel postponed until 2023);
- The University joined the Community Engagement Collaboratory Project to track community engagement.

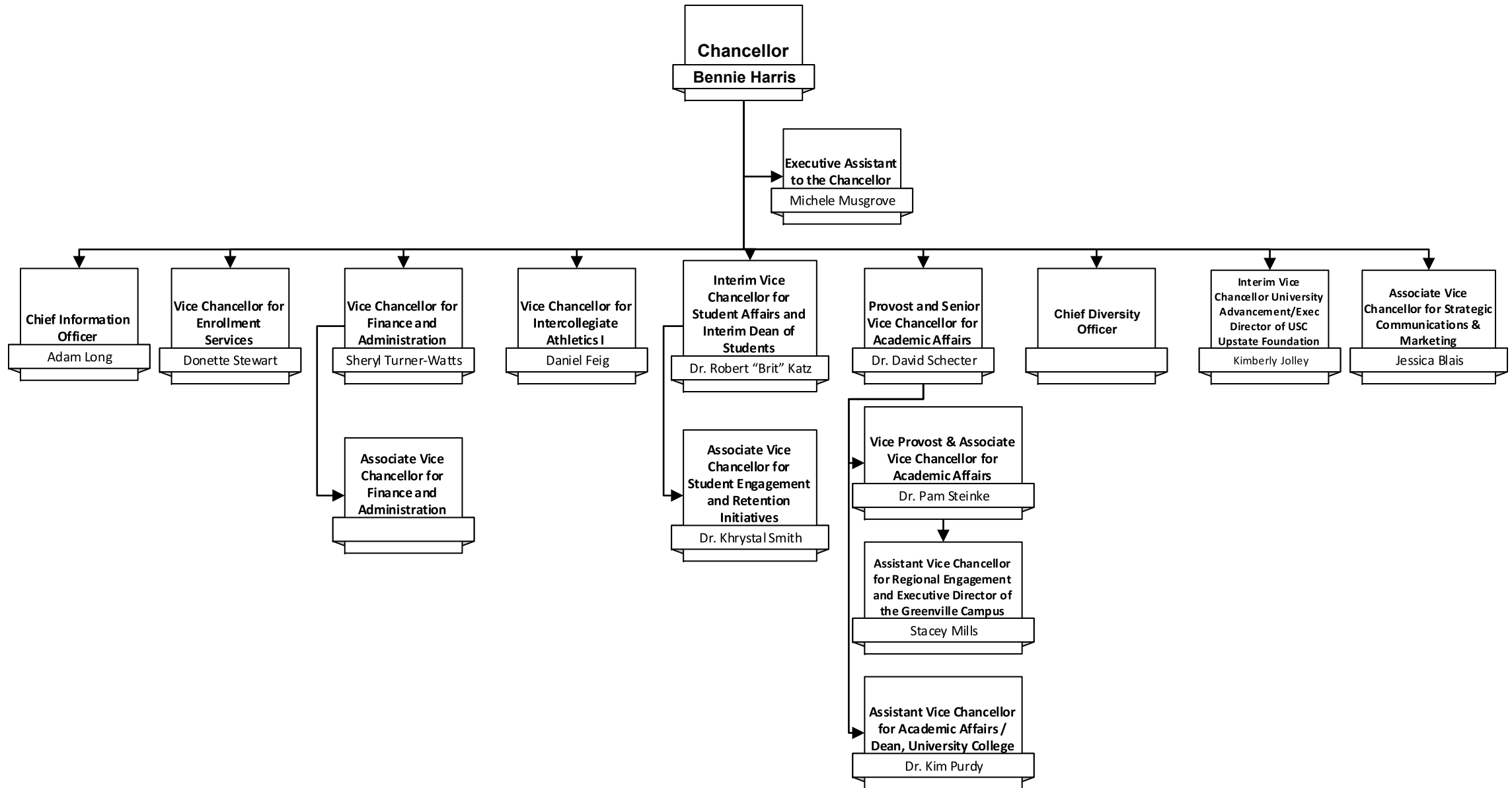
Priority 3: Being the University of Choice for Faculty and Staff, Students, and the Community

- The COVID-19 Response Team met weekly under the leadership of Mary Bucher, Special Assistant to the Chancellor for Public Health & COVID-19 Response, and led the campus through implementation of a comprehensive Campus Reopening and Risk Mitigation Plan;
- All classrooms were equipped with web cameras and technology to support two-way blended instruction, providing synchronous teaching options for most students and faculty;

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- The Center for Academic Innovation and Faculty Support, under the leadership of its Executive Director, Dr. Celena Kusch, provided extensive training to faculty as they prepared for more virtual instruction, resulting in 95% of faculty being certified to teach online;
- The Mission Statement Review Committee appointed by Interim Chancellor Cole drafted a revised mission statement with input from university constituent groups which was approved by the BOT on June 25, 2021;
- USC Upstate drafted the Compliance Certification narratives and gathered evidence in preparation for the upcoming SACSCOC reaffirmation visit in March 2022;
- After a nationwide search, Dr. Bennie L. Harris, was named Chancellor of USC Upstate beginning July 1, 2021.
