Summary of Bill:

The bill is to address the shortfall for the Public Charter School District as a result of Act 135 of 2020. The bill allows for an appropriation from the 2018-2019 Contingency Reserve Fund of nine million dollars to be distributed Public Charter School District per pupil funding for the 2020-2021 school year.

During the current school year, charter schools have grown and currently have a shortfall of \$34 million. The charter schools plan to use their current carry forward, which is \$16 million to cover part of the cost. They are also receiving \$9 million in GEER's funding. Under the current situation they are still short \$9 million. This bill will prevent a shortfall for the current school year.

Estimated Revenue Impact:

The bill will take from the 2018-2019 Contingency Reserve Fund and there will be an appropriation of \$9,000,000 to the Department of Education for distribution to the Public Charter School District.
