A JOINT RESOLUTION

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TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTINUING AUTHORITY TO PAY 12 THE EXPENSES OF STATE GOVERNMENT IF THE 2019-2020 BEGINS WITHOUT Α **GENERAL** 13 FISCAL YEAR 14 APPROPRIATIONS ACT FOR THAT YEAR IN EFFECT, AND 15 TO PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS.

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17 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of South 18 Carolina:

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20 SECTION 1. (A) If the 2019-2020 state fiscal year begins with no annual general appropriations act in effect for that year, the authority to pay the recurring expenses of state government continues at the 23 level of amounts appropriated in Act 264 of 2018 for the recurring 24 expenses of state government for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 except as 25 provided in subsection (B).

The effective dates of Parts IA and IB of Act 264 of 2018 are 27 extended until the effective date for appropriations made in a 28 general appropriations act for Fiscal Year 2019-2020, after which 29 appropriations made pursuant to this joint resolution are deemed to 30 have been made pursuant to the general appropriations act for Fiscal 31 Year 2019-2020.

(B) Notwithstanding debt service appropriations in Act 264 of 33 2018 and until the effective date of the appropriations made in a general appropriations act for Fiscal Year 2019-2020, there is 35 appropriated from the general fund of the State whatever amount is 36 necessary for timely debt service on state obligations and other amounts constitutionally required to be appropriated, including the 38 Capital Reserve Fund. The General Reserve Fund is established in 39 the amount required by law.

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41 SECTION 2. This joint resolution takes effect July 1, 2019, and 42 applies as provided in SECTION 1.

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
