Rep. LONG proposes the following amendment (LC-4129.AHB0001H):

Amend the bill, as and if amended, SECTION 1, by striking Section 16-19-5 and inserting:

Section 16-19-5. (A) For the purposes of this chapter, a person who pays a fee to participate in a game, activity, or event in which skill <u>clearly and substantially</u> predominates over chance including, but not limited to, a Professional Golf Association (PGA) Tournament; a National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR) event; a billfishing or bass fishing tournament; an Association of Tennis Professional Tour event or Women's Tennis Association Tour event; a turkey shoot; or any non-card-based predominant skill game, activity, or event, and receives a thing of value proportionate to how skillfully he plays in the game, activity, or event is not gambling.

(B) The provisions of this section are not applicable to a game, activity, or event that does not use standardized scoring or judging criteria or that involves elements of chance that are not clearly secondary to skill.
