## DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, LICENSING AND REGULATION

New

81.mou. (LLR: Mobile Optometry Units) In furtherance of expanding access to health care in unserved and underserved populations, the location and site restriction on services provided by mobile units for optometry in Section 40-37-320(B) of the 1976 Code shall be suspended for Fiscal Year 2020-21. The department and the Board of Examiners in Optometry are directed to process and issue registrations for mobile units to provide optometry services on the site of a Title I public school to students attending the school, provided the services are rendered as part of a not-for-profit program and are provided by an optometrist licensed to practice in South Carolina. The registration shall be administratively issued by the board within ten days after receipt of a registration request and following payment of a ten dollar registration fee to cover administrative costs.
