/ SECTION 1. THE SOURCE OF REVENUE AUTHORIZED FOR EXPENDITURE IN SECTION 3 IS THE FEDERAL FUNDS DISBURSED TO THE STATE PURSUANT TO THE FEDERAL "CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT" (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE CARES ACT) CURRENTLY ON DEPOSIT IN THE

CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND ESTABLISHED AND MAINTAINED BY THE EXECUTIVE BUDGET OFFICE PURSUANT TO ACT 135 OF 2020.

EXPENDITURE SECTION 2. (A) THE AUTHORIZATIONS CONTAINED IN THIS ACT ARE FOR THE MAXIMUM AMOUNTS THAT MAY BE REIMBURSED BY THE EXECUTIVE BUDGET OFFICE FROM THE CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND. STATE AGENCIES, INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING, INCLUDING TECHNICAL COLLEGES, COUNTIES, MUNICIPALITIES, SPECIAL PURPOSE DISTRICTS, AND HOSPITALS SHALL MAXIMIZE THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS MADE AVAILABLE IN THIS ACT WHEREVER POSSIBLE WITHIN THE ALLOWABLE USES.
