S. 753 -- Senator Gambrell and Cash: A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 38-7-20, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO INSURANCE PREMIUM TAXES, SO AS TO TRANSFER ONE PERCENT OF THE REVENUES TO THE V-SAFE PROGRAM; AND TO TRANSFER CERTAIN FUNDS TO THE V-SAFE PROGRAM.

Summary of Bill:

This bill requires the total amount of the one percent

insurance premium taxes to be directed to

the Volunteer Strategic Assistance and Fire Equipment

(V-SAFE) Program, which provides

grants for volunteer fire departments and combination fire

departments with at least 50%

volunteer staff.

Estimated Fiscal Impact:

This bill as amended will have no expenditure impact on

the Department of Labor, Licensing and

Regulation (LLR) because the Volunteer Strategic

Assistance and Fire Equipment (V-SAFE)

Program is currently being administered by the

department, and the addition of funds to the

program will not create any expenditures for the agency.

In FY 2020-21, this bill will shift

\$1,039,500 in revenue from insurance premium taxes

from local fire departments to LLR.
