HOUSE ETHICS COMMITTEE MAY 22, 2019 ADVISORY OPINION IN THE MATTER OF ANNIE E. MCDANIEL COMPLAINT NO. C2019-014

This is in response to the State Ethics Commission's (herein "SEC") Recommendation and Investigative Report (herein "Report") dated May 17, 2019. The House Legislative Ethics Committee (herein "Committee") met on Wednesday, May 22, 2019 and issues the following advisory opinion pursuant to S.C. Code Section 8-13-540(a).

BACKGROUND

On September 17, 2018, the SEC received a complaint filed by James E. Branham against Respondent Annie E. McDaniel, then candidate in the November 6, 2018 House of Representatives District 41 election. Respondent allegedly failed to disclose payment of a newspaper advertisement on her July 10, 2018 Campaign Disclosure Report and allegedly failed to disclose expenditures on her 2018 Initial/Pre-Election Report. Following an investigation, the SEC recommends that the Committee find probable cause is present and charge Respondent with one (1) count of violation of § 8-13-1308(F)(4) for failure to disclose a campaign expenditure; one (1) count of violation of § 8-13-1308(A) for failure to file an initial campaign disclosure upon the receipt of expenditure of \$500; and one (1) count of violation of § 8-13-1312 for failure to pay a campaign expenditure from a campaign account. On May 22, 2019, the Committee met to consider, *inter alia*, this matter.

FINDINGS

Upon review of the SEC's recommendation and relevant evidence, the Committee makes the following findings:

S.C. Code Ann. Section 8-13-1308(F)(4) provides that certified campaign reports detailing campaign contributions and expenditures must contain the name and address of each person to whom an expenditure is made from campaign funds, including the date, amount, purpose, and beneficiary of the expenditure.

S.C. Code Ann. Section 8-13-1308(A) provides:

Upon the receipt or expenditure of campaign contributions or the making of independent expenditures totaling an accumulated aggregate of five hundred dollars or more, a candidate or committee required to file a statement of organization pursuant to Section 8-13-1304(A) must file an initial certified campaign report within ten days of these initial receipts or expenditures. However, a candidate who does not receive or expend campaign contributions totaling an accumulated aggregate of five hundred dollars or more must file an initial certified campaign report fifteen days before an election.

S.C. Code Ann. Section 8-13-1312 provides:

Except as is required for the separation of funds and expenditures under the provisions of Section 8-13-1300(7), a candidate shall not establish more than one campaign checking account and one campaign savings account for each office sought, and a committee shall not establish more than one checking account and one savings account unless federal or state law requires additional accounts. For purposes of this article, certificates of deposit or other interest bearing instruments are not considered separate accounts. A candidate's accounts must be established in a financial institution that conducts business within the State and in an office located within the State that conducts business with the general public. The candidate or a duly authorized officer of a committee must maintain the accounts in the name of the candidate or committee. An acronym must not be used in the case of a candidate's accounts. An acronym or abbreviation may be used in the case of a committee's accounts if the acronym or abbreviation commonly is known or clearly recognized by the general public. Except as otherwise provided under Section 8-13-1348(C), expenses paid on behalf of a candidate or committee must be drawn from the campaign account and issued on a check signed by the candidate or a duly authorized officer of a committee. All contributions received by the candidate or committee, directly or indirectly, must be deposited in the campaign account by the candidate or committee within ten days after receipt. All contributions received by an agent of a candidate or committee must be forwarded to the candidate or committee not later than five days after receipt. A contribution must not be deposited until the candidate or committee receives information regarding the name and address of the contributor. If the name and address cannot be determined within seven days after receipt, the contribution must be remitted to the Children's Trust Fund.

A review of Respondent's bank records from Palmetto Citizens Federal Credit Union revealed a \$1,300.00 expense on April 18, 2018 to Political Election Services. Because Respondent spent over \$500.00 with this expense, she was required to file an Initial Campaign Disclosure Report no later than April 28, 2018. This expense was not disclosed on Respondent's Initial Campaign Disclosure Report filed May 24, 2018. Further review revealed this expense was paid from the Respondent's personal bank account. These actions were taken in violation of Sections 8-13-1308(F)(4), 8-13-1308(A), and 8-13-1312 of the South Carolina Ethics Act.

CONCLUSION

Accordingly, the Committee hereby **CONCURS** with the SEC's recommendation and finds probable cause is present to charge Respondent with one (1) counts of violation of § 8-13-1308(F)(4) for failure to disclose a campaign expenditure; one (1) count of violation of § 8-13-1308(A) for failure to file an initial campaign disclosure upon the receipt of expenditure of \$500; and one (1) count of violation of § 8-13-1312 for failure to pay a campaign expenditure from a campaign account.

The Committee additionally **FINDS** that Respondent must pay a penalty of \$100.00 (One Hundred Dollars and 00/100) within thirty (30) days of the date of this Advisory Opinion.

Finally, the Committee **NOTES** that there are no findings to suggest that the Respondent engaged in intentional misconduct nor did Respondent attempt to procure any personal gains.
