Dear Representative Clary:

Thank you and the other members of the Subcommittee for the opportunity to discuss with you information about the Office of the Adjutant General and the outstanding organizations and people which comprise it. After the October 10<sup>th</sup> hearing, I realized I may have been unclear in regard to my testimony pertaining to the disaster funds which are a part of the Agency budget applied toward Strategy 5.6 (Provide State-level emergency management of disasters and multi-county events). I respectfully request you accept this letter as a correction to my testimony.

The monies budgeted toward Strategy 5.6 for State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2017 are a total of \$86,723,950 which accounts for 62.99% of the budgeted expenses for SFY 2017 (see attached Slide 33 of the presentation). These monies include \$72,572,807 appropriated by the State to apply against the state match portion of the FEMA reimbursements to support Hurricane Matthew and the Pinnacle Mountain Fire. These additional monies skew the numbers and present what I feel is an inaccurate picture of how our Agency's monies are allocated. The Strategic Finances Minus State Match Funds slide (see attached Slide 34 of the presentation) presents a more accurate depiction of budgeting of the agencies funds.

Thank you for your attention to this letter. I sincerely apologize for my unclear statement and any possible misrepresentation regarding the strategic finances of this Agency.
