Questions to Criminal Justice Academy

- 1. Please list all positions at a law enforcement entity that are (e.g., 911 operator, Law Enforcement Officer, Victim Service Provider) and are not certified.
 - This depends on the agency size. It could consist of:

Certified (Law enforcement) (not an exhaustive list):

Agency Head Command Staff Supervisors Officers

Potential Units (not an exhaustive list)

Patrol
Traffic
Investigations
SRO
Special Response
Dive Team
Bomb Squad
Detention

Uncertified (Non-Law Enforcement) (not an exhaustive list):

Crime scene (can be either certified or not)
Victim Services (can be either certified or not)
911 are certified but not considered law enforcement
Public Information Officer (can be either certified or not)
Community Relations (can either be certified or not)
