I made a phone call my self to Mr. Sterling and he had absolutely no answers. SCDC needs to step up and do right ethically by these men and women. Either let these guys parole or release them. Allow county inmates already sentenced to remain in county jails and give them their good time credits and work credits so they can be released as if they actually are in a prison. SCDC standup before you loose more CO's and inmates. These inmates weren't all given a life sentence but the system at the moment is doing exactly that.
