Response to media inquiry SCDC emailed LOC

Shaw Industries operates a hardwood flooring plant at Tyger River Correctional Institution and is renovating a facility at Perry Correctional Institution.

The facility at Perry has been in the works for almost a year and is expected to employ about 50 inmates, plus supervisors from Shaw. It is in the final stages of approval from various state agencies and is expected to open in February 2020.

The work at Perry is an operation that will apply finishing touches on hardwood flooring, like polish and veneer top coats. Inmates in this program will be paid by Shaw at least minimum wage.

This program is operated under the guidelines of the federal Prison Industries Enhancement Program as certified by the Bureau of Justice Assistance. This approval is required as well as approval from the S.C. Department of Commerce, which determines that private sector jobs are not displaced by inmate labor.

It is our understanding that this is different from the products produced at Shaw's Clinton plant.

SCDC learned that Shaw would be closing its Clinton plant on Friday, June 21, 2019.

SCDC is working with Shaw to schedule a job fair and identify opportunities for displaced workers.

**COLUMBIA, S.C. –** Today, SCDC moved Death Row from Kirkland Correctional Institution to Broad River Correctional Institution to the unit originally built to house these inmates in 1988.

This move will address some of the concerns raised in a recent lawsuit filed on behalf of the Death Row inmates.

Space at Broad River was freed up when the Department of Mental Health's Sexually Violent Predator unit was moved to a new DMH facility on the Broad River campus.

For most of the Death Row inmates, the new unit will operate more like a general population dorm. They will not interact with the general population at Broad River.

Most of the inmates will have jobs on the unit such as serving meals, cleaning the common areas, laundry or assisting fellow inmates with disabilities. They also will have the opportunity to worship together in services coordinated by the institution chaplain.

For the past year, the agency has worked to strengthen the unit's security measures to house these inmates. Before renovation plans were set, agency leadership visited Death Row facilities in other states and brought back ideas and best practices to incorporate in both the physical layout and programming.

Today's move went smoothly and was completed before noon. The inmates packed their rooms this morning and the items were searched and inventoried. They carried their bags to the buses and boarded them for the short ride to Broad River. All movement on the prison complex was stopped until the inmates were secured inside the new unit, and the S.C. Law Enforcement Division helicopter watched from above. Both institutions are behind the security gate that faces Broad River Road, and there was no chance for interaction with the general public.

The staff who worked on Death Row at Kirkland transferred with the inmates and will now work at Broad River. South Carolina has 38 inmates on Death Row, but one is incarcerated in California for crimes committed there.

Death Row was housed at Broad River when the institution opened in 1988. It was moved to Lieber Correctional Institution in Ridgeville in 1997, where it remained for two decades. SCDC moved it Kirkland in Columbia in 2017 in part because the tight labor market in the Charleston region made it difficult to retain staff.

"We are glad to be able to return this unit to its original purpose," S.C. Department of Corrections Director Bryan Stirling said.

The agency Rapid Response and Special Operations Response teams, with the assistance of SCDC Police Services and SLED, carried out this operation.

**COLUMBIA, S.C.** – A former correctional officer was found guilty Thursday and sentenced to serve six years prison for introducing contraband into Trenton Correctional Institution.

Janean Lateefah Dunbar, 41, of Aiken, was found guilty of possession with intent to distribute marijuana, furnishing contraband to an inmate and misconduct in office.

Edgefield Circuit Judge William Keesley sentenced Dunbar to serve 10 years, suspended to six, plus five years probation.

Dunbar's charges stem from her arrest in June 2018, when she was paid by an inmate to bring drugs into the institution, court documents show.

The S.C. Department of Corrections pursues criminal charges against any person who is found to bring or attempt to bring contraband into an institution. This is one of the longest sentences imposed on a correctional officer in recent years

"I'd like to thank Solicitor Rick Hubbard and his team for prosecuting this very serious matter," S.C. Department of Corrections Director Bryan Stirling said. "Anytime someone brings contraband into an institution and breaks the public trust, there needs to be consequences."

## **State Grand Jury Indicts Two Prison Guards for Alleged Involvement in Smuggling Contraband within South Carolina Prisons**

(COLUMBIA, SC) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced today that the South Carolina State Grand Jury has issued an additional indictment in the case known as "Cash Cow", involving allegations of sophisticated and highly lucrative conspiracies to smuggle large amounts of contraband into the South Carolina prisons.

The indictment alleges that Carmen Amelia Carpenter, a former SCDC Lieutenant at the Turbeville Correctional Institution, and Chesley Lavon McFadden, a former SCDC Sergeant at the Turbeville Correctional Institution, used their "position[s] as correctional officer[s] to facilitate the unlawful introduction and distribution of contraband into a prison facility". Both Carpenter and McFadden were charged with one count of Criminal Conspiracy, which is punishable by 5 years and up to a \$5000 fine, and Common Law Misconduct in Office, which is punishable by up to 10 years and a fine in the discretion of the court.

The investigation is ongoing and anyone with information regarding contraband in SCDC should contact SLED or the Attorney General's Office.

The case was investigated by the South Carolina State Grand Jury, which was assisted in this case by a partnership of the Attorney General's State Grand Jury Division, the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division, the South Carolina Department of Corrections' Division of Police Services, the Richland County Sheriff's Department, the Fifth Circuit Solicitor's Office, the Laurens County Sheriff's Department, and the Eighth Circuit Solicitor's Office. The cases will be prosecuted by State Grand Jury Division Chief S. Creighton Waters, Assistant Attorney General David Fernandez, and 5<sup>th</sup> Circuit Assistant Solicitor John Conrad.

Attorney General Wilson stressed that all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
