The vision of SCDOT is to deliver, operate and maintain a world-class, 21st century, multimodal transportation system that enables the Palmetto State to continue to grow our economy, enhance our communities and improve our environment.

Our Mission

SCDOT shall have as its functions and purposes the systematic planning, construction, maintenance, and operation of the state highway system and the development of a statewide intermodal and freight system ... the goal of the Department is to provide adequate, safe, and efficient transportation services for the movement of people and goods.

(SC Code Section 57-1-30)



Governance

Secretary of Transportation

- Chief Administrative Officer of the Agency
- Appointed by the Governor
- Must be screened and found qualified by the Senate Transportation Committee
- Confirmed by the State Senate

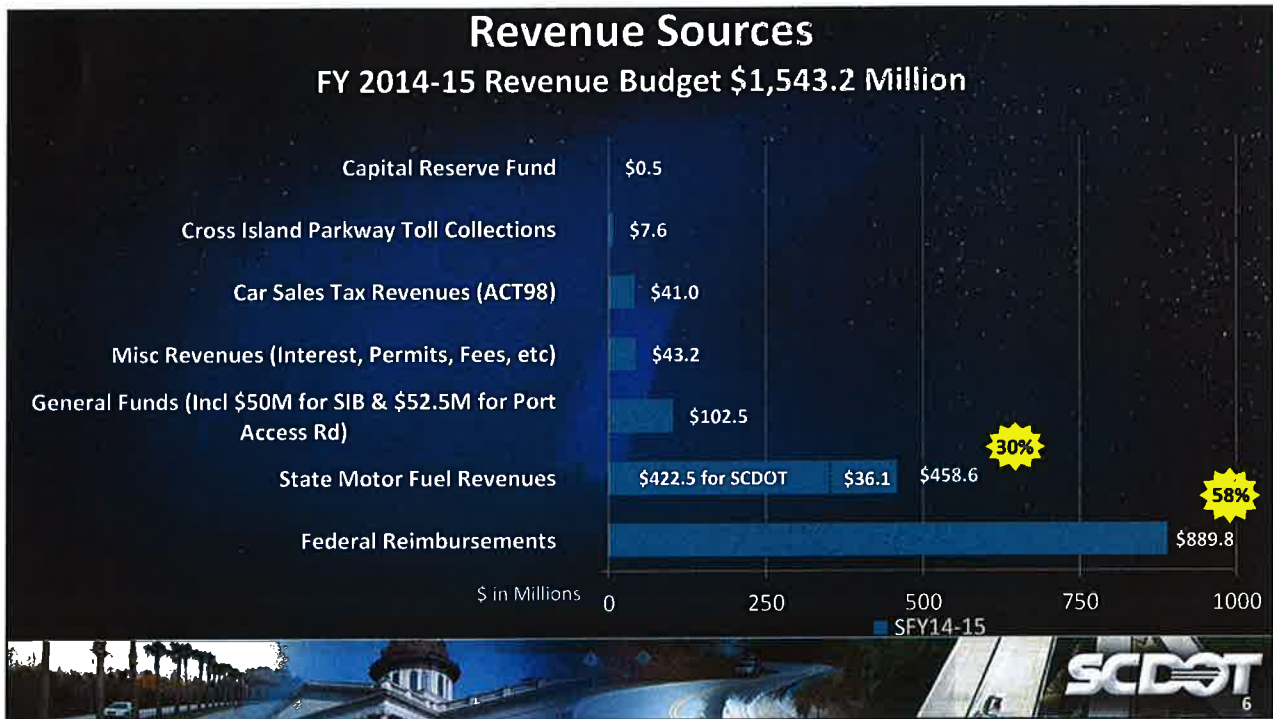
SCDOT Commission

- Administrative and governing authority of the agency
- All candidates must be screened and found qualified for by the Joint Transportation Review Committee
- Seven members elected by the General Assembly from each congressional district for a term of four years
- One at-large member appointed by and serving at the pleasure of the Governor
- Oversees the agency's internal audit function

Transportation System Profile

Roads (2013 Assessment Data)

- Over 41,000 centerline miles - 4th largest state-owned system in nation
- Half are not eligible for federal-aid funds and must rely on state funding
- The Non-Federal Aid eligible routes carry only 7% of SC's traffic
- 75% of SC's traffic is carried on Interstate (28%) and primary routes (47%)
- Pavement Conditions Statewide (by lane mi): **46% Poor**, **38% Fair**, **16% Good**
- Factoring in the traffic carried by route type: **35% of SC's traffic is riding on Poor pavements**, **36% riding on Fair**, **29% riding on Good**.



Transportation System Profile

Bridges (as of Jan 2015)

- Over 8,000 bridges
- 1,600 (19.0%) are Substandard
 - 822 (9.8%) are Structurally Deficient, 778 (9.2%) are Functionally Obsolete
- 390 (4.6%) are Load Restricted
- 10 (0.1%) are Closed
- Structurally Deficient Bridges: 28 Interstates, 262 Primaries, 532 Secondaries

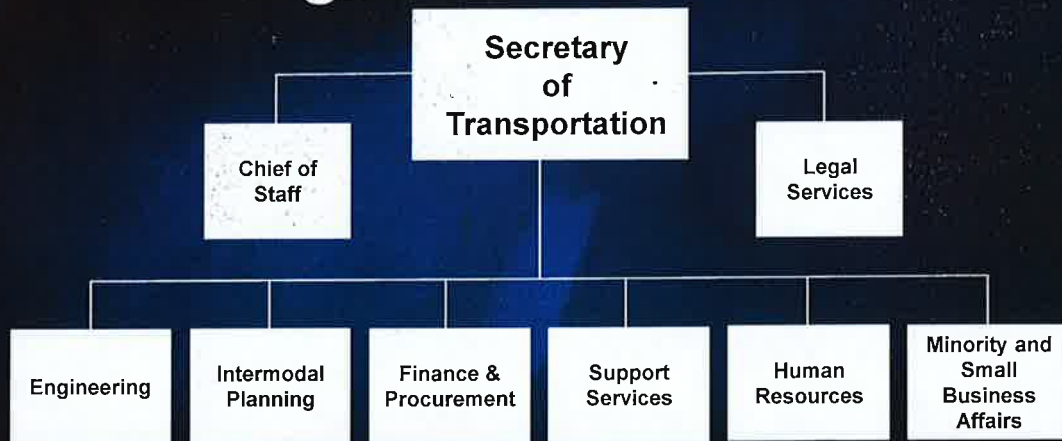


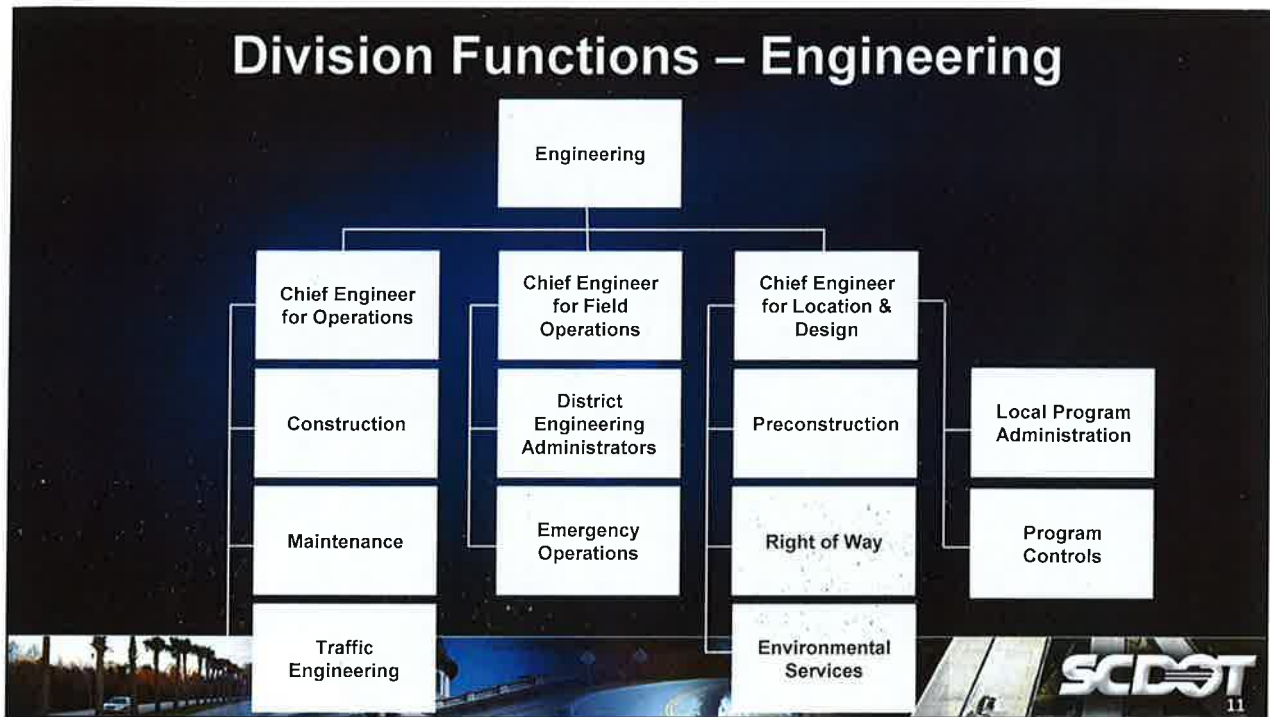
Organizational Profile

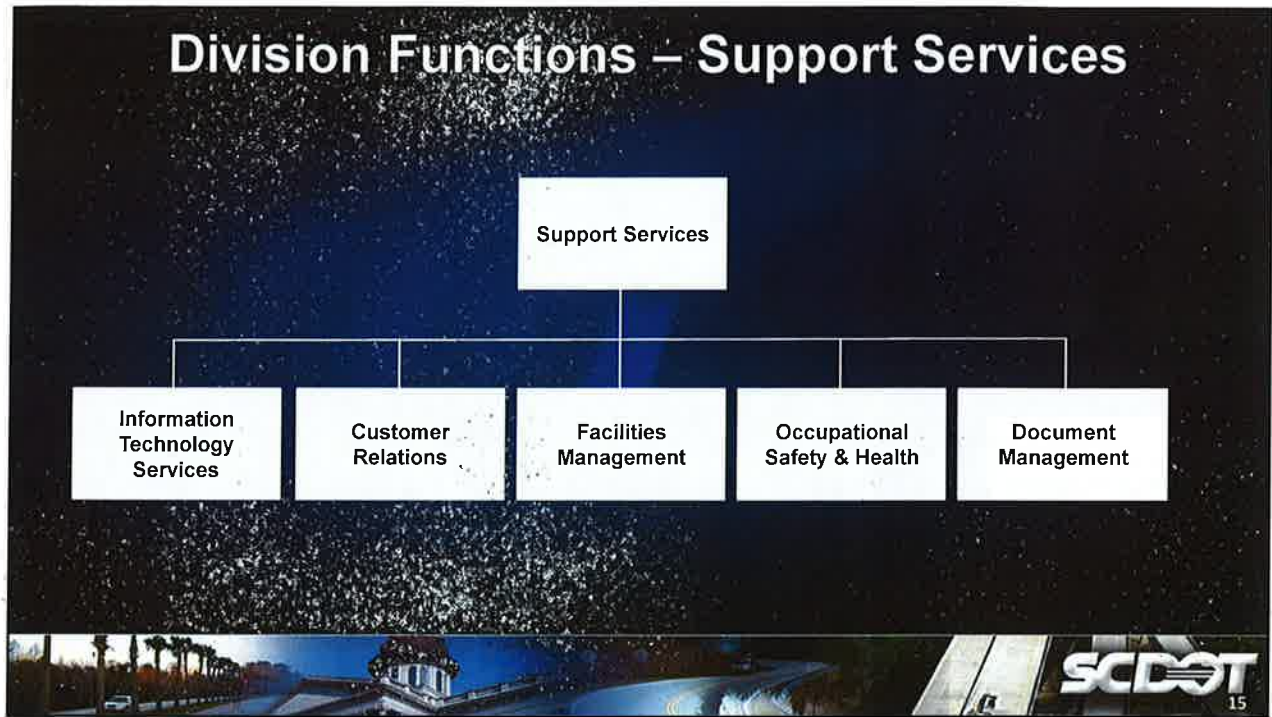
