RE: Establishment of Residence - Revised
Listed below are guidelines regarding residency requirements for unformed personnel who desire to apply for promotion or transfer to a troop/unit in accordance with SCDPS Policy \# 400.03.

- Major - - is to reside within assigned region or within thirty (30) statute miles of Highway Patrol Headquarters.
- Captain, Lieutenant, Administrative Sergeant, CRO trooper - are to reside within assigned troop or within thirty (30) statute miles of troop headquarters.
- First Sergeant and below - are to reside within assigned post/unit or within thirty (30) statute miles of post/unit headquarters.
- Highway Patrol's MAIT units are to reside in their assigned region or within thirty (30) statute miles of region office.
- Highway Patrol's ACE unit is to reside in their assigned region.
- Highway Patrol's A-CERT corporals are to reside in their assigned region.
- Highway Patrol's CRO corporals are to reside in their assigned region.

These guidelines are to take effect September 1, 2007 and will be incorporated into the Highway Patrol Manual of Operations.
